

Catholic School Office Releases Five-Year Average ACT Scores

The table below reflects the achievement of graduates of the Catholic high schools in the Diocese of Providence on the ACT over time and an indication of the extent to which they are prepared for college-level work.

The ACT consists of curriculum-based tests of educational development in English, mathematics, reading and science designed to measure the skills needed for success in first-year college coursework. The table shows the five-year trend of ACT-tested graduates. Beginning with the 2013 Graduating Class, all students whose scores are college reportable, on both standard and extended time tests, are included in this report.
