This position requires but is not limited to the following duties:

- *Acting as a witness to Gospel values by modeling the teachings of the Catholic Church
- *Supporting and adhering to the Code of Conduct and policies and procedures of the school and Diocese
- *Maintaining confidentiality regarding school matters
- *Providing effective programs of instruction for students in the absence of their daily classroom teacher(s)
- *Using effective instructional methods/models according to professional standard practice
- *Practicing positive, consistent discipline in the management of the classroom
- *Establishing and maintaining standards of student behavior for a productive learning environment
- *Taking all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities
- *Maintaining current and accurate records according to school policy
- *Maintaining records as required by law, Diocesan policy, and administrative guidelines
- *Demonstrating professionalism in conduct, demeanor, and work habits
